Status of factories in the semiconductor and device business affected by earthquakes in Kumamoto, as of Apr. 18, 2016

As announced in the internet dated 18th April, 2016 by Mitsubishi Electric Corporation, we, Mitsubishi Electric Europe B.V. Semiconductor Division, inform the latest status of the above issue. We apologize for all the inconveniences caused, and we highly appreciate your kind understanding on the current situation.

1. Power Device Works (Kumamoto): Wafer factories in Koshi area

- Operation: currently under suspension.
- Injuries: there were no seriously injured employees (confirmed).
- Facility and equipment damage: no serious damage to the buildings. Inspections are continued to the extent possible amidst aftershocks. Mitsubishi Electric will promptly make an announcement as soon as it determines when operations can be expected to resume.

*Assembly factories in Fukuoka and Hyogo area are operating as usual.

2. LCD factory: Melco Display Technology Inc. in Shisui area


- Operation: currently under suspension.
- Injuries: still in the process of confirming for a few employees, but we have determined there are no seriously injured employees other than these persons whose status is still being confirmed.
- Facility and equipment damage: no serious damage to the buildings. Inspections are continued to the extent possible amidst aftershocks. Mitsubishi Electric will promptly make an announcement as soon as it determines when operations can be expected to resume.

3. High-frequency and optical device factories: Melco Advanced Device Co. in Isahaya, Nagasaki

- Operation: operating as usual without any problem.
- Injuries: none.
- Facility and equipment damage: none.
